


Using the Edit Area and Query Dialog

Use the Edit Area and Query dialog to create edit areas you cannot easily create using the Edit Area Tool.

Step	Action	Notes
1	<p>Click the Edit Area and Query Dialog button (image below).</p> 	
2	<p>Build the query using the keypad interface (images below).</p>  <p>You can build your query in the Query text entry space (example below).</p> 	<p>It is possible to use the Edit Area and Query dialog to generate queries that search for either multiple thresholds or only one in a string of queries, which are the AND (&) and OR () operators, respectively.</p> <p>The example query searches for where both T < 75 and PoP > 10 are satisfied. If the OR operator was used instead, the query would search for where either T < 75 or PoP > 10.</p>
3	<p>Click Submit to submit the query.</p> <p>Result: The edit area is created in the Spatial Editor.</p>	<p>The edit area changes dynamically when going forward or backward in time based on data in that time period.</p>
