




Using the Move/Copy Tool

Use the Move/Copy Tool to move a feature to a new location while preserving the data values.

Step	Action	Notes
1	Identify the data feature you wish to move.	
2	Draw an edit area around the feature using the Edit Area Tool (example image below). 	For information on how to use the Edit Area Tool, refer to the Using the Edit Area Tool job sheet.
3	Select the Move/Copy Tool (image below). 	

Step	Action	Notes
4	<p data-bbox="287 233 1081 296">Left click and hold over the edit area, and drag the data to the desired location (example image below).</p>  <p data-bbox="287 747 1110 779">Result: Moving grid values may result in a map looking like the following:</p> 	<p data-bbox="1127 233 1386 363">A white, unhatched outline of your data appears after you click and drag the data.</p>
5	<p data-bbox="287 1232 1057 1329">Clean up the grid as needed. You can use any editing tools from the Button Bar, such as the Pencil and Contour Tools, to smooth out the data.</p>	<p data-bbox="1127 1232 1393 1499">This is a necessary step because moving higher values of a weather element to an area of lower values creates a strong gradient that is not meteorologically possible.</p>
